	<b>Location:</b>	<p>The signs shall not be located so as to obstruct or interfere with highway maintenance, impede movement of pedestrian or vehicular traffic, impede the use of utilities or bus stops or otherwise create a hazard.</p> <p>No sign shall be located on a centre median of a roadway.</p> <p>The signs shall be located at least 1.8 metres from the curb, asphalt or gravel shoulder of a roadway, on the side used by pedestrians.</p> <p>Where a boulevard exists, the sign may only be on the side of the sidewalk furthest from the road.</p>	Not on public property
	<b>Duration:</b>	Placed only during hours of open house	Sold/leased signs must be removed within 30 days if a property is no longer for sale/lease or within 30 days after the property is advertised as sold/leased, whichever occurs first.

	<b>Duration:</b>	Placed no earlier than two (2) hours prior and removed within one (1) hour of completion	No mention

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	<b>Location:</b>	An open house directional sign may be erected on that portion of a street located between the curb or edge of the travelled roadway and the sidewalk, or where no curb exists, such sign may be erected on the un-travelled portion of the right-of-way closest to the outer edge of the travelled roadway.  Open house signs are not permitted to be displayed on traffic islands or medians.	On the property which is for lease/sale  "Coming Soon" signs can be displayed on a property coming up for sale. Maximum of TWO (2) weeks before the MLS® Listing Date.  Directional "house for sale" signs are not permitted.  "Sold" signs are now permitted on the property being sold.
	<b>Duration:</b>	Only during open house hours. Open House Signage can only be displayed between 10:00am and 6:00pm on the day of the open house.  Open House Directional signs must display the hours of the open house.	Only on property when property is for sale/lease  "Sold" signs must be removed within THIRTY (30) days following the sale of a property.
	<b>Permits:</b>	Not required	Not required
